

HOW DO I REGISTER FOR CLASSES?

GO TO: MYECC.ESSEX.EDU

1. Click on My.Essex.Edu.
2. Click on the “Web Services” tab.
3. Select “Enter Secure Area.”
4. Enter your ID number and Password.
5. Click on “Student Services & Financial Aid.
6. Click on “Registration.”
7. Click on “Register Add/Drop Classes or Withdraw Classes.”
8. Use the pull down menu to select a term, then click “Submit Term.”
9. Scroll down to Add Class section and enter the Course Reference Number (CRN) in the “Add Class” table.
10. Click “ Submit Changes.”
11. To look up more classes to add, click “Class Search” and repeat the steps above.
12. When you are finished adding classes, scroll down and click “Fee Assessment.”
13. You can pay your bill on web services.

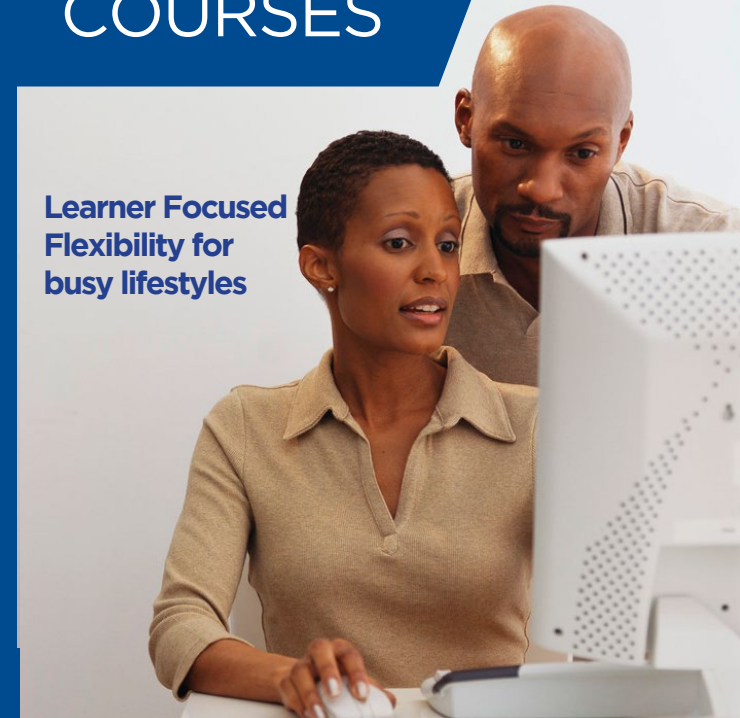
- Create a schedule that works for you.

WHAT IS AN ONLINE COURSE?

An online course is taught 100 percent online. Students and the instructor will work both asynchronously and synchronously, with discussions on a regularly scheduled basis. To determine if an online course is right for you, you'll need the basic technical knowledge to take advantage of these classes.

WHAT IS A HYBRID COURSE?

A hybrid course combines face-to-face classroom instruction with online learning. The course is structured in such a way that students will be doing a significant amount of course activity online, and spending less time in a classroom. Traditional face-to-face instruction is reduced, but not eliminated.
