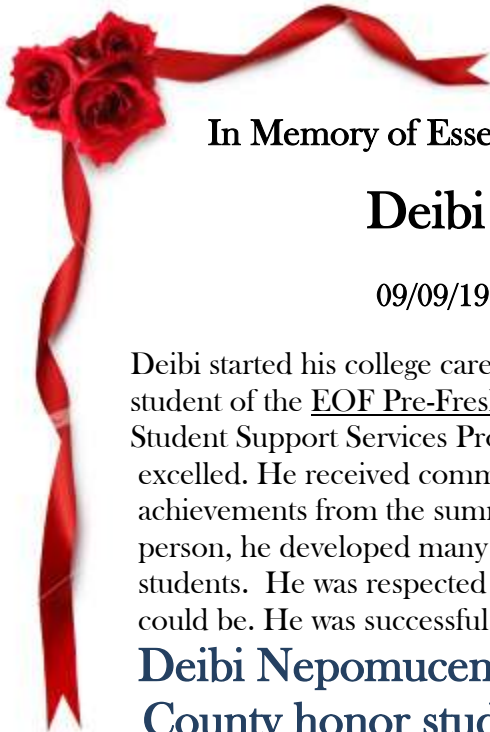
EOF Application Campaign-CLOSED
