To keep your funding for the new Academic Year 2010-11 you must renew your FAFSA on line, review your email address provided to FAFSA and look for the AIR (additional information request) from HESSA.

Failure to respond to the AIR information will result in cancellation of your state funding (tag and EOF).

Returning Students applying for Summer I 2010 must have completed two semesters

Every student who wishes to receive PELL summer Funding should have:

General Requirements

- Have filed 2009-2010 FAFSA
- Must not be in default of a loan or owe a refund to a federal program
- Have an eligible EFC
- Must have a good Satisfactory Academic Progress status
- Must have a high school diploma or GED (if not, must take and pass the ATB Test)
- Have all required documents submitted
- Must be matriculated in a degree or certificate program.

Specific Requirements:

- Be registered before a review will take place (**Please see Below before register**)

Students who were registered for 2 Semesters (Fall and Spring) must have completed at least 24 Credits.

- Register for at least 6 Credits

For Students who were registered for 1 Semester Fall or Spring

- Register for 3 Credits or More
