PARCC Test Prep

PARCC (Partnership for Assessment of Readiness for College and Careers) is a set of assessments aligned to the Common Core State Standards which measure whether students are on track to be successful in college and their careers. These assessments are computer based and students must be proficient in computer usage. This test prep course involves familiarizing students with the format of PARCC tests, teaches them how to solve questions and how to maximize performance on open-ended questions. **Note: The PARCC exam will take the place of the NJASK exam in most school districts.**
