Cleo Hill, Sr. served as the Essex County College (ECC) Head Men's Basketball Coach for more than 24 years from 1971-1995 and Director of Athletics from 1984–1995, where he was among the Top Ten Winningest Active Coaches in the National Junior College Athletic Association and New Jersey in Percentage; accomplished three Region XIX Coach-of-the-Year, two New Jersey College Basketball Coaches' Association Coach-of-the-Year awards, and accomplished a Twenty-Five Year Coaching Record of 489 Wins, and 128 loses; and,

WHEREAS,

As the ECC basketball coach, on January 19, 1974, his team accomplished Most Points Scored in a Collegiate Basketball Game . . . Essex (210) vs Englewood Cliffs (67); earned eleven Garden State Athletic Conference titles, three Region XIX Championships, two Inter-Regional Championships, three National Championship Participants, four Christmas Classic Championships, and one Undefeated Regular Season; and,

WHEREAS,

Prior to coaching basketball, Cleo Hill, Sr. was the Number 1 Draft Choice of the St. Louis Hawks; set a St. Louis Hawks/National Basketball Association Record for Most Points (26) Scored by a Rookie Guard on Opening Day, and was named to the All-NBA Rookie Team; and,

WHEREAS.

Cleo Hill, Sr. was inducted into several Halls of Fame, among them the South Side/Malcolm X Shabazz Sports Hall of Fame, Newark, NJ; Newark (NJ) Athletic Hall of Fame; Central Intercollegiate Athletic Association Hall of Fame, Hampton, VA; Holcombe Rucker Professionals Hall of Fame, Harlem, New York; The Brooklyn (NY) USA Athletic Association Basketball Hall of Fame; The Winston-Salem State University Sports Hall of Fame, Winston-Salem, NC; and, was featured in an ESPN documentary "Black Magic" and on the cover of the book, "The Salt Mine, Who Will Tell Your Story"; and,

The Board of Trustees and the College community are desirous of a lasting tribute to Cleo Hill, Sr. which will distinguish his extraordinary leadership, accomplishments, contributions, and dedicated service; also to ensure his permanent imprint on the athletic landscape of Essex County.
