Definitions

TUITION AND FEES

Tuition and Fees account for 52.52% of revenue, the largest percentage of the Operating Budget. Tuition and Fees, net of Waivers, consist of the following: In-County Tuition and Fees, Out-of-County Tuition and Fees, Out-of-State Tuition and Fees, Tuition – Non Credit, General Fees, Lab Fees, Deferred Payment Fees, Off-Campus Fees, Graduation Fees, Transcript Fees, Application Fees, Late Fees, Void Reinstatement Fees, and Saturday Youth Program.

APPROPRIATIONS

Appropriations are from the State of New Jersey and the County of Essex.

INVESTMENT INCOME

Investment Income represents revenue from the State of New Jersey Cash Management Funds, Mutual Funds and Stocks, and Checking Accounts.

OTHER INCOME

Other Income includes:


- Indirect Cost Reimbursement which is the money received directly from the Federal Government as compensation for administering Federal programs. Grants also generate indirect cost reimbursement of between 8% and 45% of the salary cost associated with each grant. The income generated depends on the number of grants and currently there is a decrease in the number of grants being administered by the College.
- 2. Miscellaneous Other Income includes income from Facility rentals, library fines, security IDs, vending machines, Cafeteria commissions, Income from outsourcing the Bookstore, the parking deck, services provided to the County and the Vocational school, selling of the Public Safety Academy (PSA).
- 3. Auxiliary Income which includes income derived from the reimbursable deposits of key cards.

PRIOR YEAR'S UNEXPENDED FUNDS

Prior Year's Unexpended Funds represents the transfer of a portion of the excess of revenues over expenses from previous years to balance a current year's budget. This transfer is not accounted for as an additional source of revenue.


Colleges must submit the following by no later than May 31, 2019:

WHEREAS: State Statute 18A-64A-16 requires the Administration of the College to adopt a balanced budget; and

WHEREAS: Budget Requests were disseminated to each College funded Department for completion based on the College's Strategic Plan and approved goals and objectives for the fiscal year; and

WHEREAS: The requests were summarized and compared to the approved revenue base and adjustments were required to reduce the budget requests in order to present a balanced budget; and

WHEREAS: The College's operating budget is funded through tuition and fees, governmental appropriations, and other income sources; and

WHEREAS: Cost containment is an ongoing imperative as evidenced by the Board's Declaration of Fiscal Exigency.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Essex County College Board of Trustees as follows:

1. The Essex County College Board of Trustees approves the College Operating budget in the amount of \$58,031,800 for Fiscal Year 2019-2020

WHEREAS: The State of New Jersey provides funding for major capital renewal and replacement (CRR) programs known as Chapter XII and Essex County College ("College") has received an allocation of \$3,600,000; and

WHEREAS: The College has requested its full allocation of \$3,600,000 for the Fiscal Year 2019-2020 which will commence on July 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS: Essex County ("County") is a funding partner and is required to share in 50% of the CRR cost approved by the State for the College and at this date, Chapter XII Capital Funds are included in the Governor's budget; and

WHEREAS: The College has redeveloped its Facilities Master Plan for the term of 2019-2023 and has asses the state of its infrastructure and equipment in order to prioritize capital improvement initiatives, and re-align resources with its strategic goals, and

WHEREAS: The College seeks to identify and describe the Capital Renovation and Renewal (CRR) projects on which the Chapter XII Funding will be spent for Fiscal Year 2020. The projects are:

1. Infrastructure upgrades and repairs

The buildings throughout the institution are in need of major repair. Sub-projects include: Replacement of roofing, ceiling systems, lighting & lighting control, flooring and HVAC; Renovation of existing spaces; And, upgrade cabling infrastructure in remaining areas.

2. Campus enhancements

The College is looking to invest in improvements to modernize the campus in order to attract students and increase enrollment. These enhancements include: painting throughout the institution, outdoor landscaping and pavement upgrades, new indoor and outdoor building signage and wayfinding redesign, new seating and furnishings throughout, and the addition of charging stations where feasible.

3. Security management

The College is implementing a unified door access and security management system. The system will integrate with the College's existing networked technologies and other software applications to assist in emergency response.

WHEREAS: The College's Chapter XII Capital Fund Budget request for \$3,600,000 will be submitted to the Board of School Estimate for approval at its next meeting.

NOW THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Essex County College Board of Trustees as follows:

1. The Board of Trustees of Essex County College authorizes and directs that the College's Chapter XII Capital Funds for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 in the amount of \$3,600,000 be allocated for the Enhancements and Upgrades set forth in the recitals herein.
