**RECOMMENDATION:** It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of Essex County College accept the Release and Hold Harmless Agreement between Essex County Vocational Technical Schools and Essex County College for Essex County College's usage of the Newark Tech Campus Gymnasium as an indoor training facility for the college's athletic programs.

**BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:** The Essex County College Gymnasium and Physical Education Building is being occupied as a Covid-19 Vaccination Site. As a result, the Essex County College Athletic Department needed to secure an off-campus location for indoor athletic practices. An agreement to utilize the Newark Tech Campus gymnasium, for the Essex County College Track and Field and Basketball programs, was orchestrated by the administrations of Essex County College and Essex County Vocational Schools. There will be no cost for the use of the facility, and will last through the end of the month of April 2021.

**FISCAL NOTES:** There is no financial impact to the college. Essex County College is not being charged for the facility usage.
