WHEREAS, Essex County College needs to approve a contract of \$35,975.00 to LS2 Investment, Inc., 2398 Boulevard, 203 Longueuil, QC, J4G1B6, vendor approved by the State of New Jersey under Small Women Business Enterprise (SWBE) to support student and faculty user experience with online learning. The Teameo product will remove the number of clicks students need to access resources, creating a more efficient means to navigate digital student resources. Teameo will simplify Moodlerooms template management and offer new curation tools for virtual classrooms. This product will ensure that faculty can grow their academic outcomes and meet the objectives set forth by Academic Affairs. The agreement is from March 21, 2023, through March 20, 2024, in which contract goods are exempt from bidding pursuant to the provisions of County College Contracts Law N.J.S.A.18A:64A-25.3 and N.J.S.A.18A:64A-25.5.a(19), Providing goods or services for the use, support, or maintenance of proprietary computer hardware, software peripherals, and system development for the hardware; and

**WHEREAS,** Essex County College wishes to award said contract without the need for public bidding in compliance with the provisions of the County College Contracts Law, N.J.S.A.18A:64A-25.1 et seq., and the provisions of N.J.S.A.19:44A-20, 4 et seq.; and

WHEREAS, The award of this purchase shall be made as "Non-Fair and Open" pursuant to the provisions of N.J.S.A. 10:44A-20,4. When the aggregation rules (NJAC 5:34-8-2) are applied, the value of this acquisition exceeds \$17,500.00; and

**WHEREAS,** The Comptroller of Essex County College has determined and certified in writing that the funds are available for this purpose;

The Essex County College Board of Trustees hereby authorizes and directs the appropriate officials of the College to award a contract with **LS2 Investment, Inc.** for \$35,975.00 for the Teameo product to support student and faculty user experience with online learning from March 21, 2023, through March 20, 2024.
