BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE:

In Fall 2021, OSHE surveyed thousands of students enrolled in institutions of higher education throughout the State on the economic, financial, and mental tolls of the COVID-19 pandemic. Not surprisingly, the results were troubling: over 70% of students rated their current stress and anxiety levels as either higher or much higher than the previous year and 40% of students indicated that they were concerned about their mental health in light of the pandemic.

Essex County College like most institutions of higher education provided some level of mental health support for students prior to the pandemic, the levels of need have now greatly exceeded the capacities of campuses to meet those needs.

This grant is designed to encourage institutions of higher education and community providers to develop partnerships and expand professional capacity to meet the direct and unique needs of students, with a distinct focus on traditionally underrepresented student populations as they were disproportionately impacted by the effects of the pandemic.
