HOW TO APPLY Step 1. Apply for Admission by completing and submitting this application. All applications must include the following:

- Completed and signed application form
- ___\$30 non-refundable application fee. The application fee must be in the form of a check or money order. The application fee must be in United States dollars and drawn

on a

- United States bank.
- Proof of high school graduation. (Reviewed and evaluated by an evaluation service)
- ___ Test scores (TOEFL-ibt, TOEFL, SAT, ACT, Accuplacer) or copy of college transcript.
- Completed and signed application for Form I-20
- ___ Notarized Sponsor's Affidavit of Financial Support with required evidence.
- ___ Notarized Sponsor's Affidavit of Free Room and Board with required evidence (if applica-

ble).

- Step 2. Application is reviewed. Upon approval, an acceptance letter and Form I-20 will be sent to
- you. You will also receive information about the International Student Orientation and Registration dates.
- Step 3. Apply for your passport as soon as possible. Some countries prohibit their citizens from applying for a passport before receiving the Form I-20. If you have that problem, you should apply for college admission as soon as possible.

Upon receipt of your passport and F-1 student visa:

Step 1. Attend the International Student Orientation. Take the Placement Test. This test will be used determine the level of your English and Math classes for the first semester, so please take it seriously. If you have questions regarding the test, please contact the International Student Advisor at ISSO@essex.edu

Step 2. Register for Classes.

Please note that International Students are not eligible for the in-county tuition rate.
