
### **Campus Climate Survey of Students Spring 23**

The Campus Climate Survey of Students is a yearly survey administered by the Institutional Effectiveness, Planning and Assessment Office. The survey was open from February 24, 2023, until March 15, 2023. The questionnaire listed 6 questions, including four demographic questions, two Likert scale questions and one open end question. The survey was sent to 5742 email addresses of currently enrolled students via Qualtrics. A total of 729 responses were recorded. The survey yields 12.7% response rate.
