
The Essex County College Graduate Survey is administered by the Office of Institutional Effectiveness, Planning and Assessment three times a year to the most recent group of graduates. This survey aims to understand the graduate's perspective on their experience at Essex and how it has prepared them for life after graduation. This year, the Office of IEPA has modified the instrument to include questions aiming to gain indirect data for the Essex County College Competencies, the General Education Goals, and the Program Learning Outcomes. Questions were also added to gain demographic information. This modification came in between the distribution for the Fall graduates and the Spring graduates. This report combines the three different instruments due to ongoing modifications. The first version of the survey was sent out in October 2023 to 357 graduates, and we received 34 responses. The second version was sent out in February 2024 to 205 graduates, and we received 40 responses. The third version was sent out in June 2024 to 420 graduates, and we received 88 responses. With the three versions combined, the response rate was 16%.

Which statement best describes your primary objective for first attending Essex?












