

The Essex County College (ECC) Alumni Survey is administered by the Office of Institutional Effectiveness, Planning and Assessment (IEPA) three times a year to the graduates of the year prior. This survey aims to understand the employment status of ECC's alumni. This year, the Office of IEPA has modified the instrument to include questions on demographics, their perceived understanding of ECC's General Education Goals and Competencies, and their use of the career center. There is three versions combined in this report. The first version of this survey was sent to 352 Summer 2022 Graduates and we received 10 responses. The second version was sent to 247 Fall 2022 Graduates and we received 20 responses. The third version of this survey was sent out to 428 Spring 2023 Graduates and we received 31 responses. That yields a 5.9% response rate across all three versions.

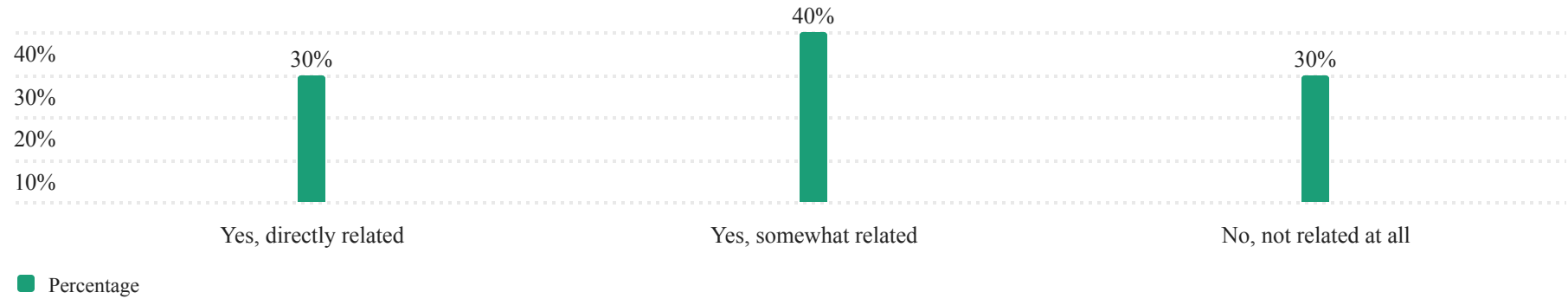
Are you employed as of now? (Choose only one that best describes you)

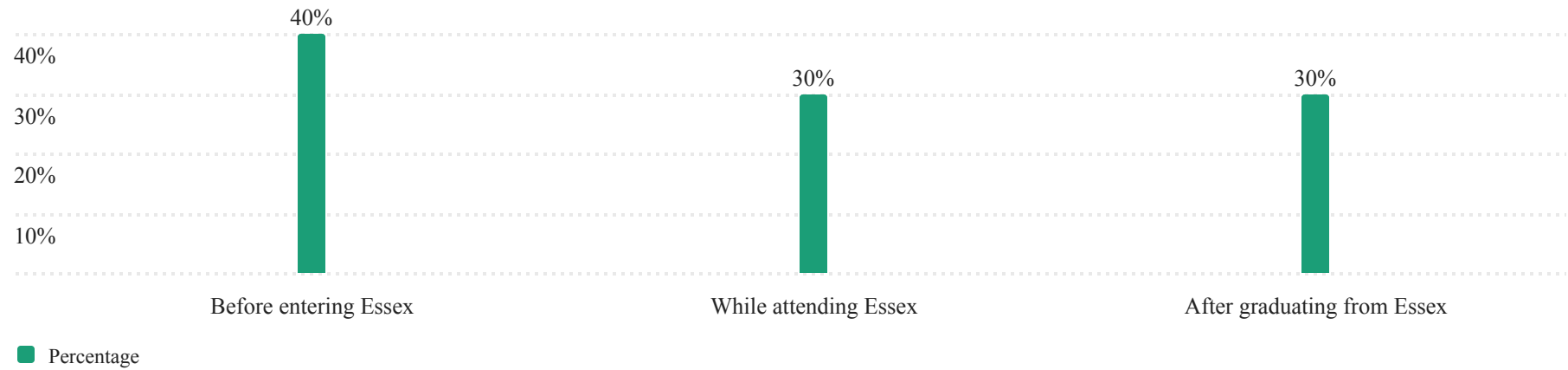
## Is your current job related to the program of study you completed at Essex?

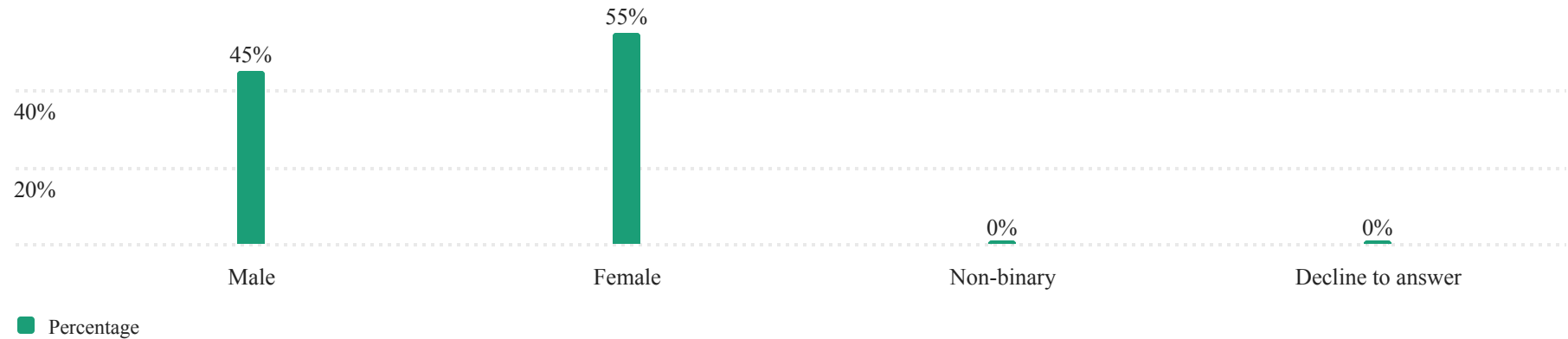

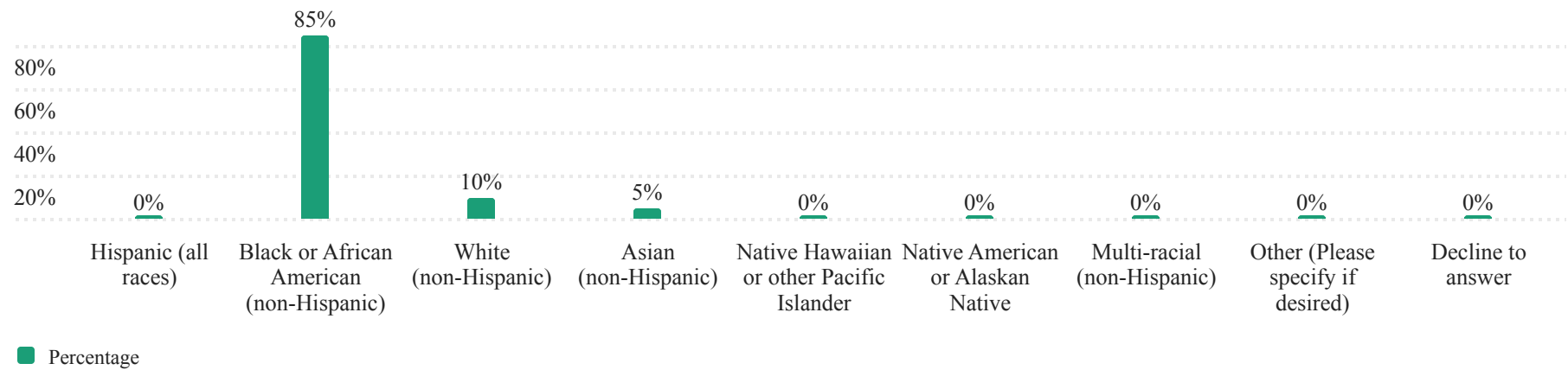

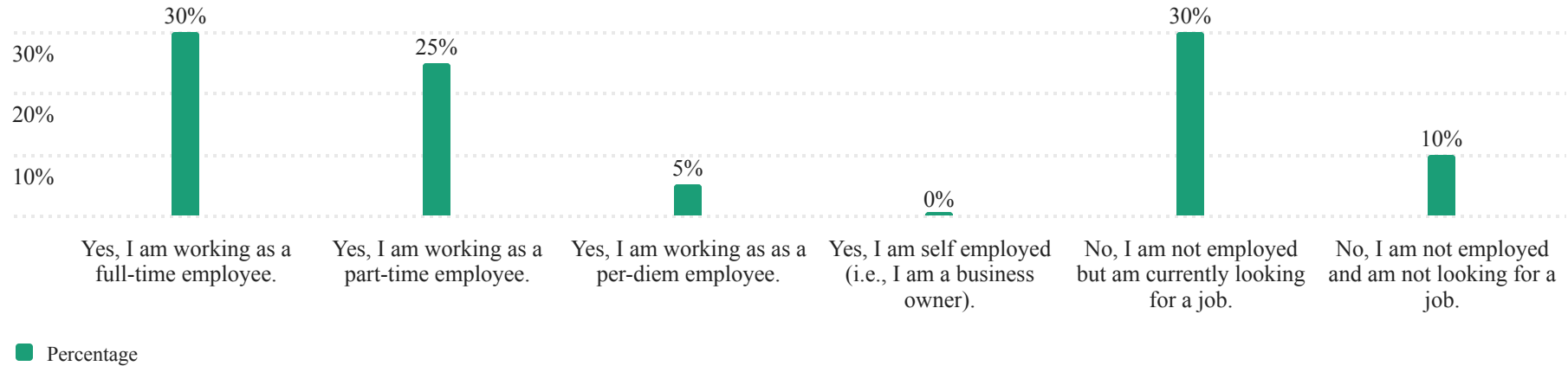

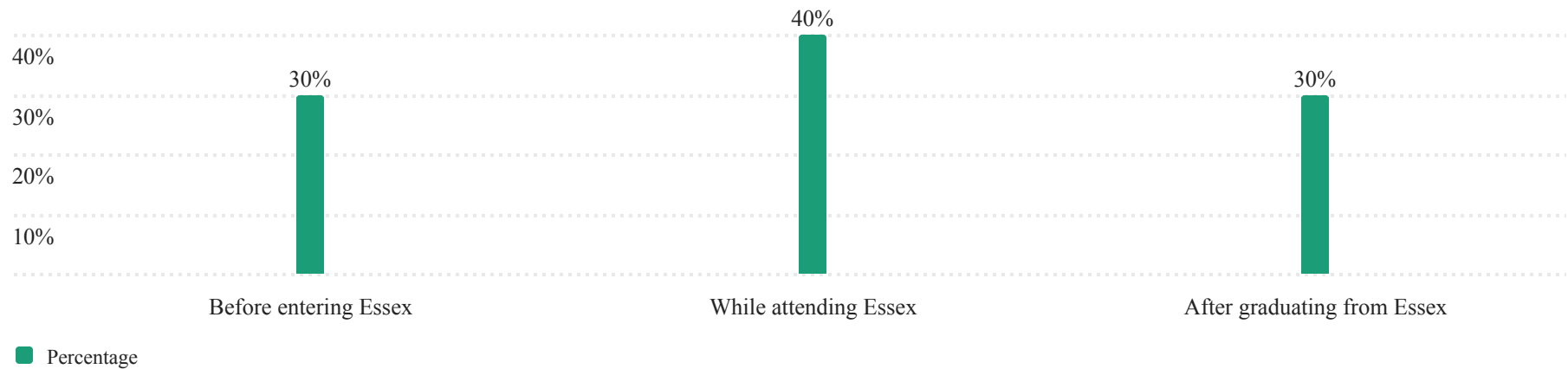

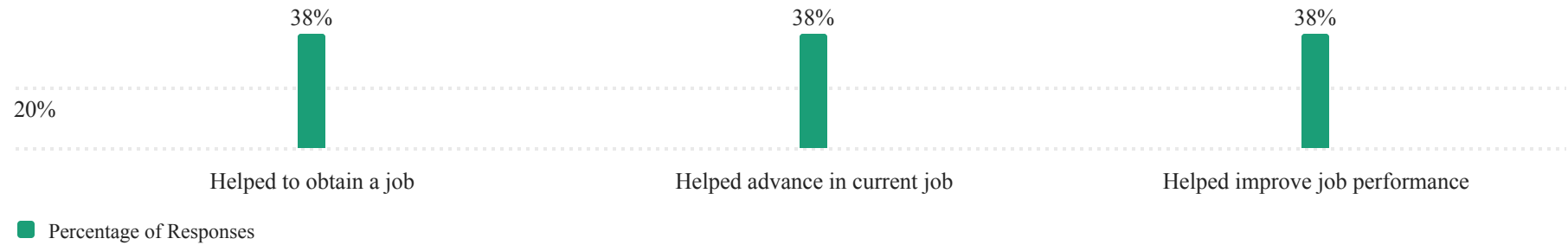

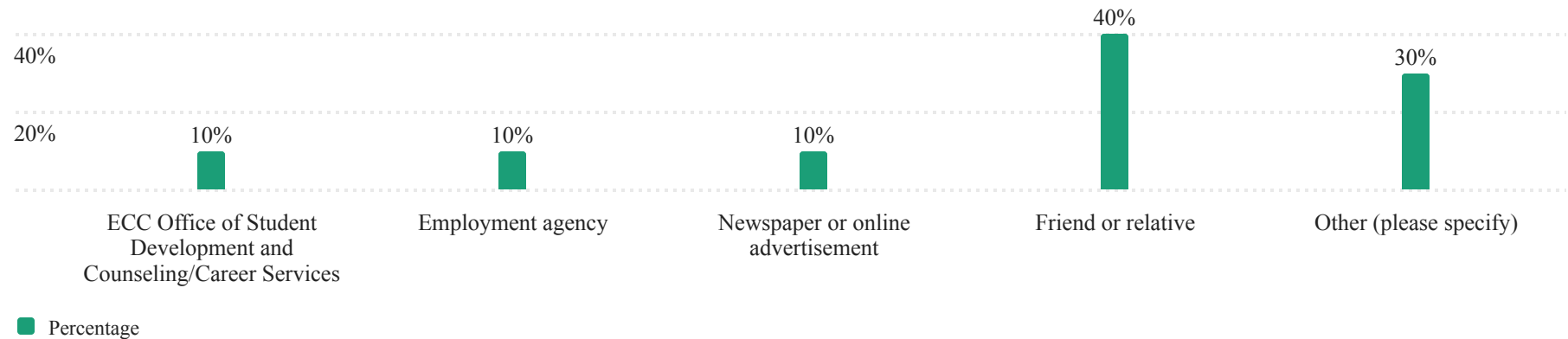

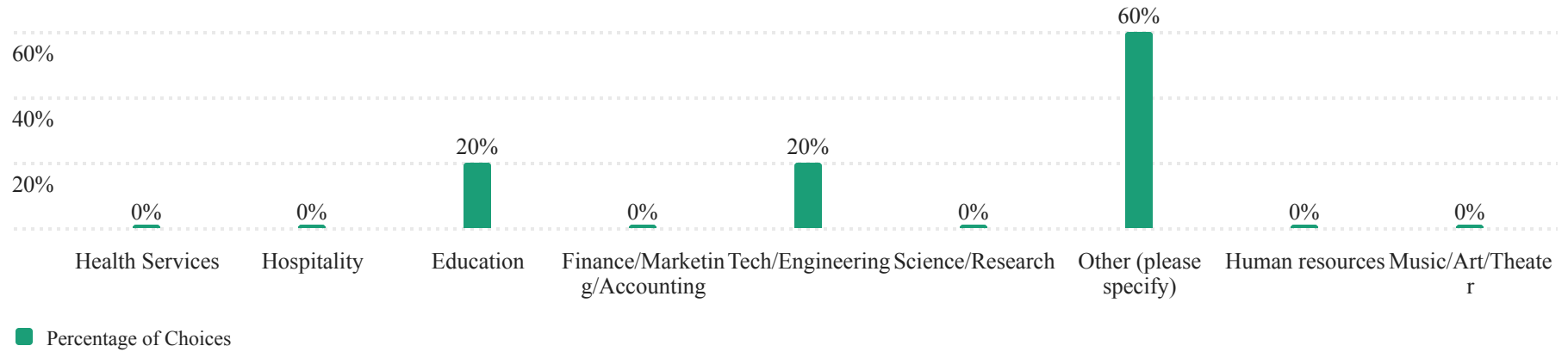

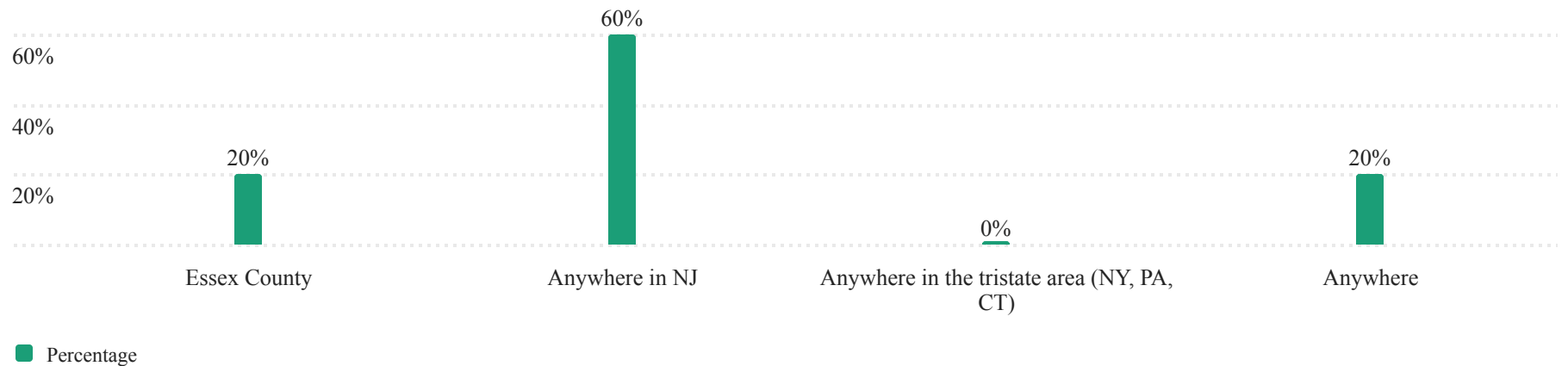

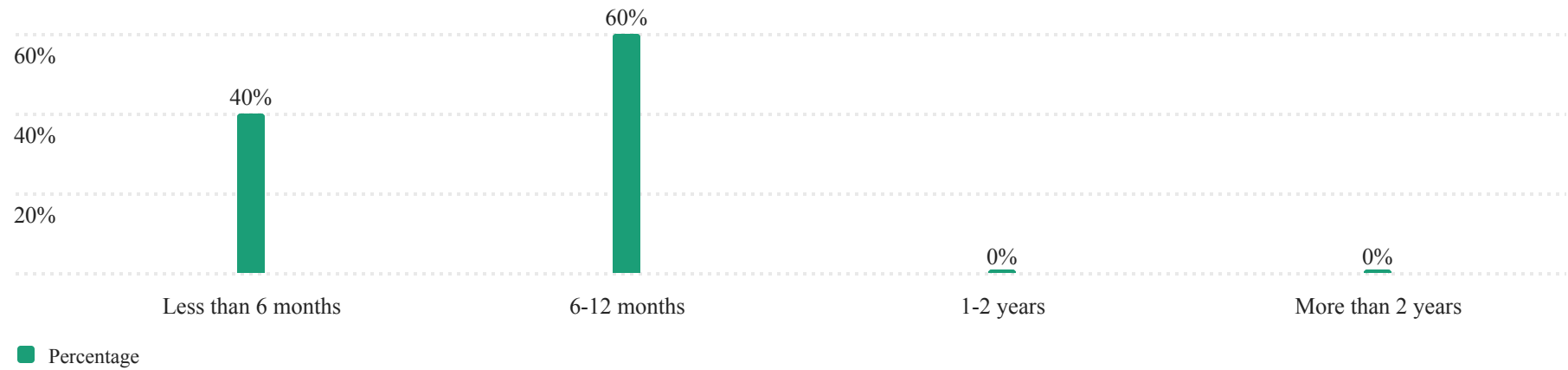

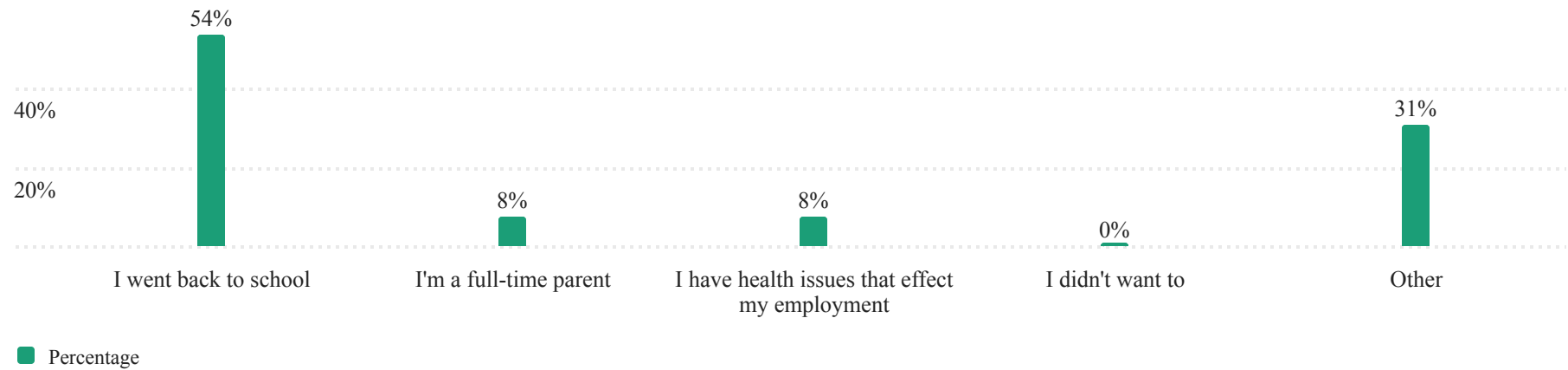

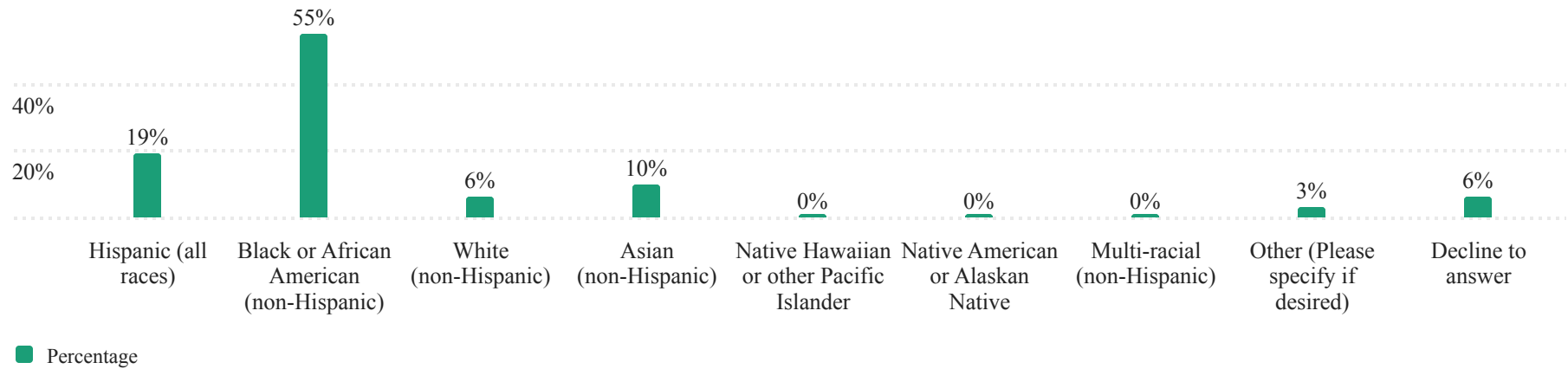

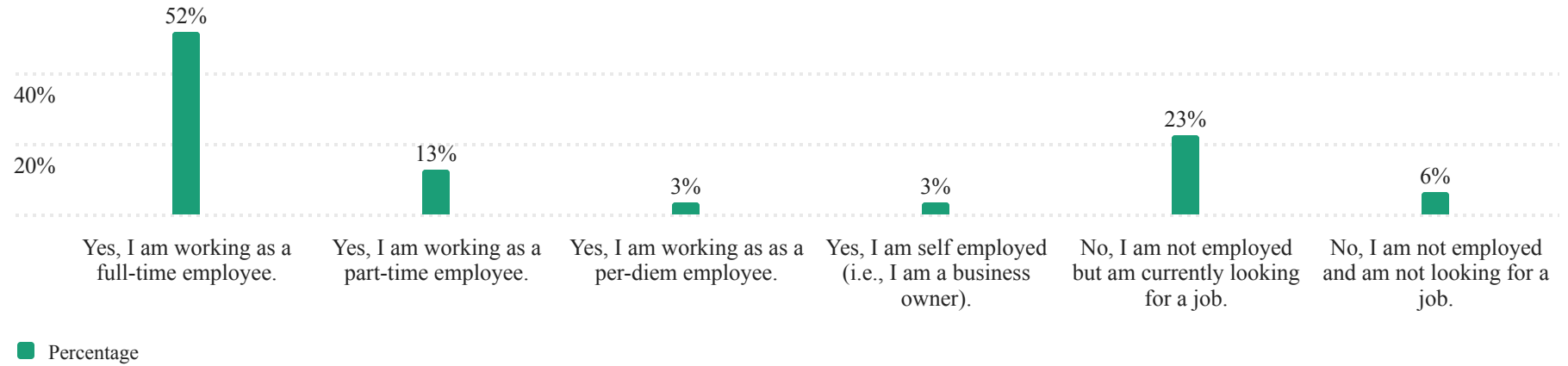

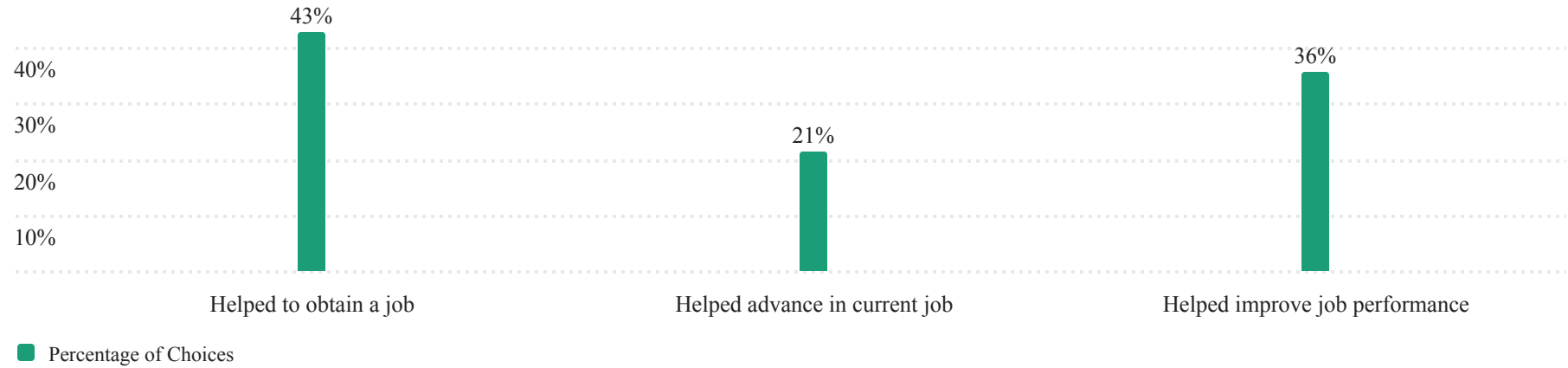

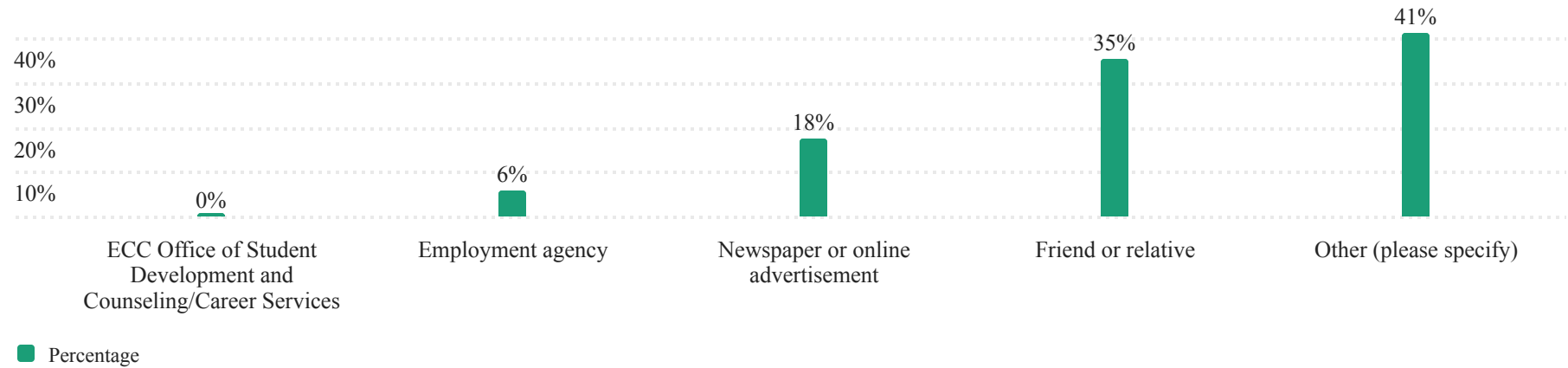

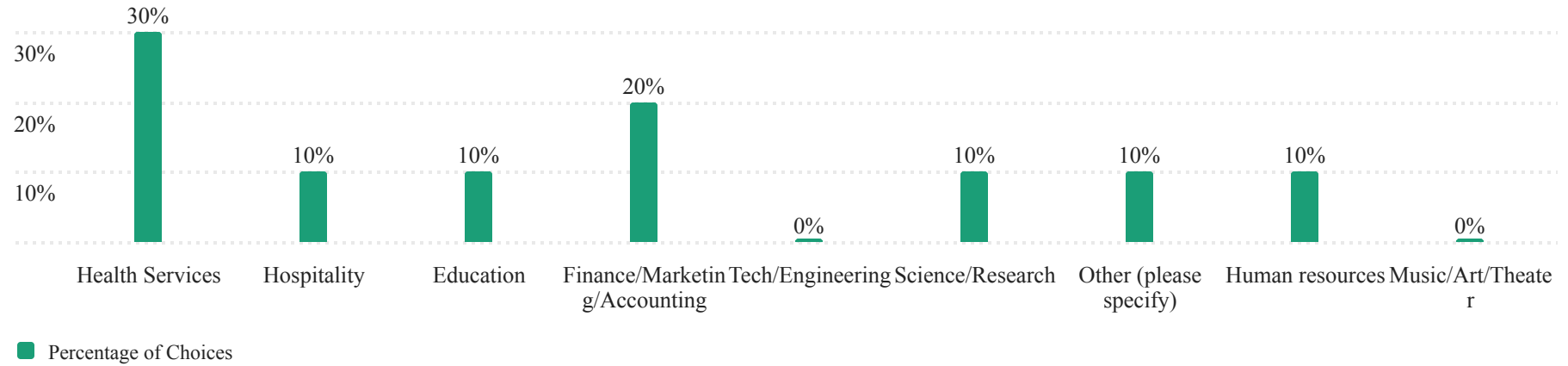

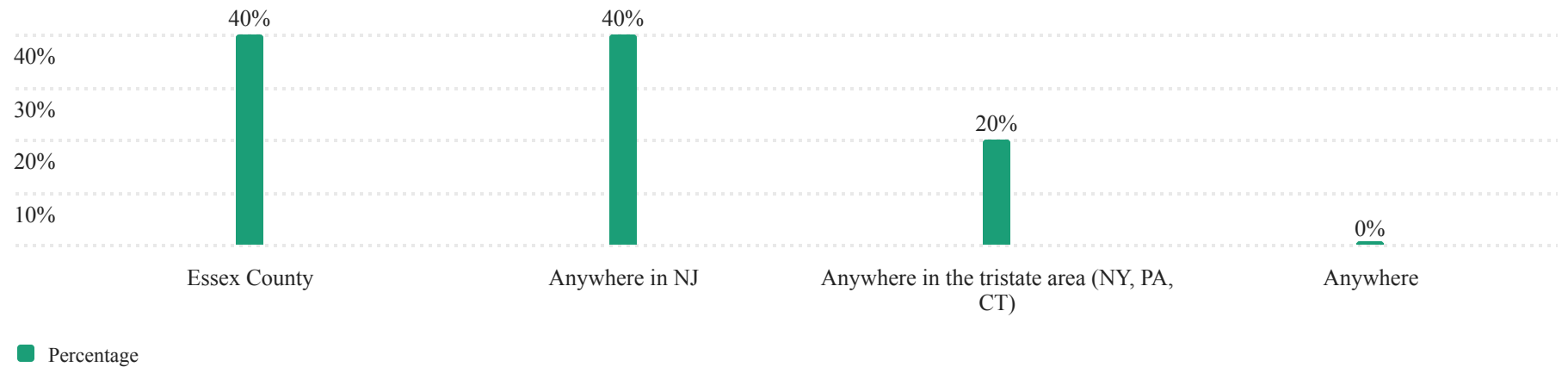

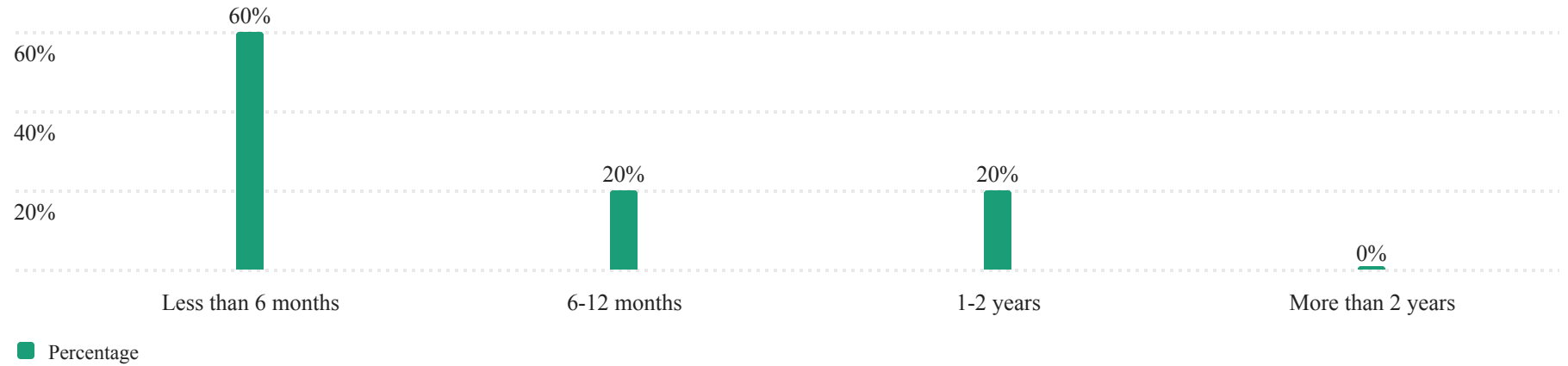
## What is the location of the jobs you are applying to?

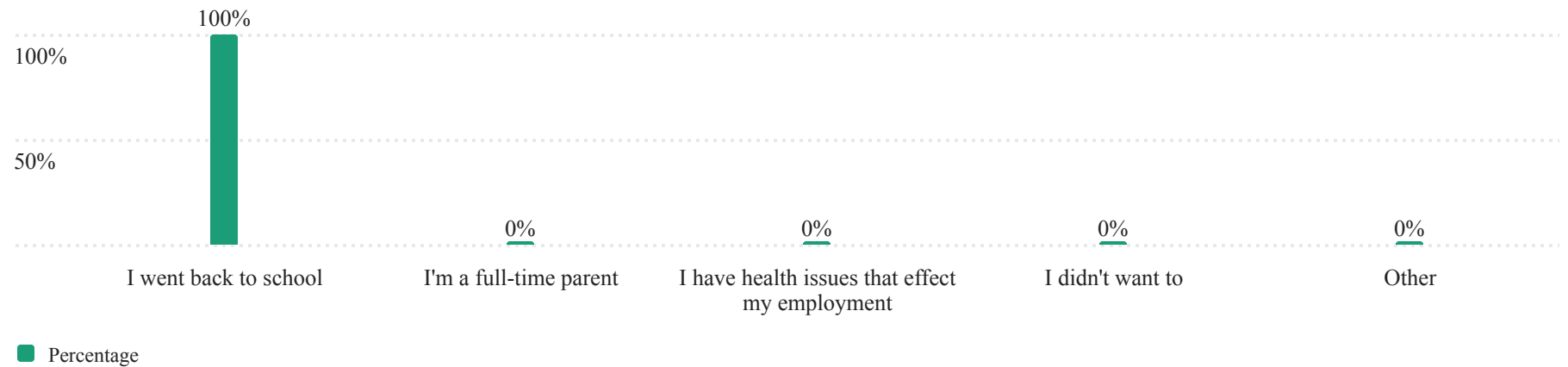
