
The Office of Institutional Effectiveness, Planning, and Assessment administers the Student Satisfaction and Engagement Survey annually in the Fall semester. The aim of the survey is to understand how the students are interacting with the school and their satisfaction on the services provided to them. This survey opened on October 22nd, 2024, and closed on November 19th, 2024. The survey was sent to 7026 Essex County College (ECC) students, and 551 responses were received, yielding a 7.8% response rate.

The gender makeup was 71% female, 26% male and 1% non-binary. Women are slightly overrepresented in this sample and men are underrepresented compared to the college averages. The sample was made up of 53% Black or African students, 29% Hispanic students, 5% White students, 2% Asian students, 2% Multi-Racial students, and 9% of respondents responded other or decline to answer. This is mostly representative of the college average, with the Black or African students being slightly overrepresented.


The respondents of this survey were 92% college level students, and 8% were in high school. The majority of respondents were continuing students (58%) and the rest were new students (42%). Within this group of respondents, 53% have been attending ECC for less than a year, 31% have been attending between 1-2 years and 15% have been attending for 2 or more years. The enrollment status of the respondents were 66% full-time students and 34% part-time. The college is average is 50.2% full-time and 49.8% part-time, therefore part-time students are underrepresented in this sample.





How challenging do you find your courses?




How would you characterize the academic expectations that faculty place on students?




How often do faculty members encourage interaction with themselves outside of class?
