RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of Essex County College approves the renewal of the Distance Education Certificate Programs Agreement between Essex County College, hereinafter referred to as "Essex" and George Brown College, hereinafter referred to as "GBC" for the purpose of establishing Electronics, Electromechanical, Automation, Robotics, Programmable Logic Controllers (PLC), PLC Technician II (PLC II), Electric Vehicle (EV), Wind Turbine (WT), Solar Energy Technician (ST) and Solar Panel Installer, distance education certificate programs from September 1, 2025 to August 30, 2027.

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE: GBC located in Toronto, Canada is a fully accredited, post-secondary institution of education and one of the largest colleges in Canada, with 19,000 full-time and 60,000 part-time students. GBC has a history of success in delivering online technical training one-year (32-week) certificate programs which has resulted in a large enrollment base of students across Canada and throughout the U.S. GBC currently has over 6,000 students in the U.S. enrolled in distance education certificate programs, both directly through GBC and through a network of U.S. College and University partners. GBC also has a successful track record delivering training to over 200 Corporate Partners including Boeing Aerospace, GM, Amazon and Tesla.

Essex will leverage GBC's success in delivering distance education certificate programs by partnering with GBC to offer Electronics, Electromechanical, Automation, Robotics, Programmable Logic Controllers (PLC), PLC Technician II (PLC II), and Electric Vehicle (EV) Wind Turbine (WT), Solar Energy Technician (ST) and Solar Panel Installer. Additionally, GBC's partnership model is quite simple and requires minimal investment from Essex.

FISCAL NOTES: As detailed in the Agreement, tuition revenue will be shared among the parties as follows: Essex 35% and GBC 65%

RECOMMENDATION: It is recommended that the Board of Trustees of Essex County College approves the College Readiness Now XII Program Agreement between Essex County College, hereinafter referred to as "Essex" and the New Jersey Council of County Colleges, hereinafter referred to as "NJCCC" for the purpose of establishing a College Readiness Now XII Program in the amount of \$35,310 to be delivered by Essex to Newark High School students from July 1, 2025 to August 20, 2026.

BACKGROUND AND RATIONALE: For twelve years, The New Jersey Council of County Colleges (NJCCC) has partnered with the State of New Jersey Office of the Secretary of Higher Education (OSHE) and New Jersey's 18 community colleges to increase college readiness of high school students prior to graduation. Essex's College Readiness Now XII Program proposes to enroll 75-100 Newark High School 9th, 10th, 11th and 12th grade students in a six-week Summer Boot Camp aimed to not only prevent the "Summer Slide" which often happens to disadvantaged students during the summer months, but also, propel students, particularly those entering their senior year into a college-ready mindset.

FISCAL NOTES: There is no fiscal impact to Essex.
